The organisers of World Space Week 2013 need your help to collect a rock for the 'Earth Master Sample', which will be made into a unique set of crystals that are part Earth and part Mars.

All the rocks collected will be ground to a powder, along with a Mars meteorite, then made into crystals by renowned jeweller, **Swarovski**. The Earth/Mars crystals will be presented to policy makers around the globe as reminders of our thirst for knowledge about Earth, Mars, and the rest of the solar system.



To participate, simply collect a fist-size rock sample from wherever you are, take photos of the collection site, note the geographical coordinates and send the sample to the Austrian Space Forum, Sillufer 3a, 6020 Innsbruck, AUSTRIA.
