



## Equatorial Sundial

Print both pages on the same sheet. For stability, print directly in cardboard.
Cut out the Sundial, by the cutting marks.


- Cut out the interior black lines.
- Select and cut out the latitude closest to your location (1).

- Fold in half, by the dotted line, and lift both triangles until they make a 90° angle with the dial (2).

- Glue the inside (this page) (3).
- Place the Sundial so the front faces North (or South, if you're in the southern hemisphere).

- Without changing its orientation, in winter you'll tell the time on the back dial.

- In the Summer, add one hour for daylight savings.
