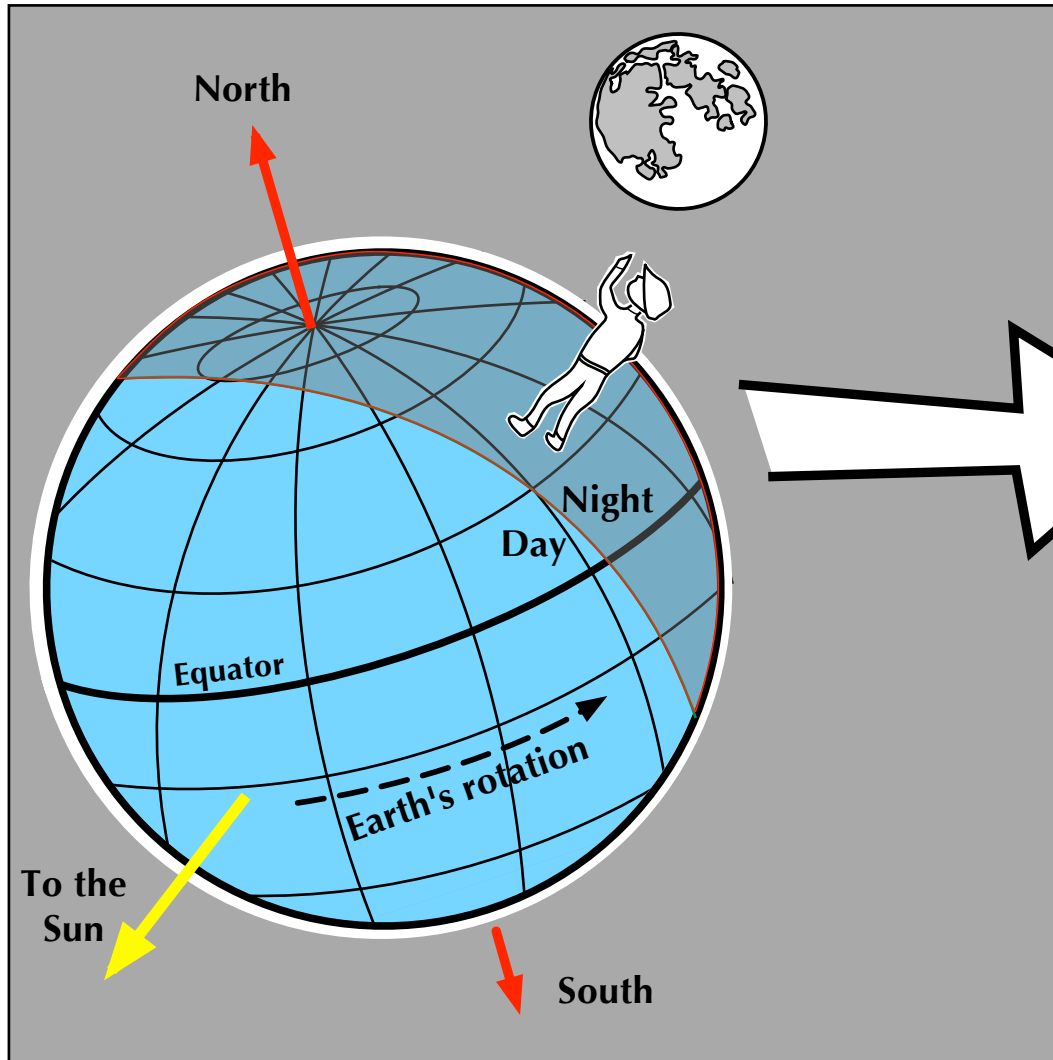


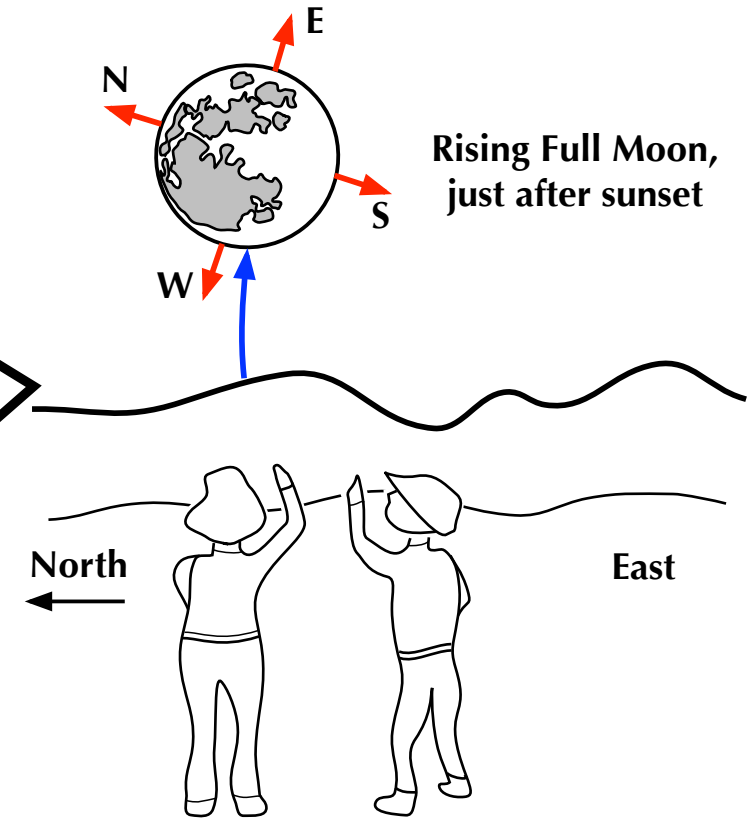


Rising Full Moon at a latitude of 45° North
