Global Astronomy Month is Astronomers Without Borders' signature program and continues to grow rapidly as the world's premier astronomy event. The <u>GAM 2013 web site</u> is the hub of all activities, providing social networking and integration with social media sites like Facebook to expand its reach. Events are registered by participants worldwide, and articles, blogs and program descriptions are mirrored on astronomy blogs and web sites around the world. Exposure goes far beyond the Global Astronomy Month website.

Global Astronomy Month 2013

Each year a broad range of 30 to 40 programs fills the month, with GAM events taking place around the world. Again in 2013 thousands will view through telescopes provided by amateur astronomers and science centers during the Global Star Party, Saturn Watch, SunDay, and Lyrid Meteor Watch.

Online telescope observing again features live interaction between the host and attendees worldwide in five special GAM events. The Online Messier Marathon kicks off GAM on April 1, and Cosmic Depths closes it on April 30, each with tens of thousands of observers taking part and interacting online.

Partner programs bring in new audiences and participants: measuring light pollution worldwide in <u>Globe at Night</u>, classrooms discovering asteroids in the <u>International Asteroid Search Campaign</u>, clubs connecting across borders to observe together in <u>30 Nights of StarPeace</u>, and the <u>Cosmic Concert</u> with a new composition performed live online each year accompanied by spectacular celestial imagery.

Each year GAM fosters new, innovative programs. New in GAM's 2013 edition is an expanded AstroArt program that puts space artists and filmmakers at center stage. Online screenings of space- and astronomy-related films will feature panels of astronauts and other experts to answer questions from a worldwide audience.
